Main Accountabilities:

The following types of responsibilities are envisioned:

- Perform as Pilot-In-Command and/or Instructor Pilot, accomplishing scheduled and unscheduled flights as well as post maintenance flights, acceptance flights, and support missions as prescribed by the customer;
- Conduct advanced planning, aircraft launch, and mission execution;
- Conduct mission analysis, risk management/mitigation, and accept or reject mission changes while actively flying;
- Deploy single pilot or as lead for multi-ship elements to conduct Day/Night/NVG/IFR VIP operations;
- Within the UAE or deployed, conduct single pilot operations through complex airspace, to unimproved landing areas while providing instruction to non-qualified pilots;
- Brief crew members and non-crew members on safety, emergency procedures, and scope of mission. Pilot aircraft and command crew to accomplish assigned mission;
- Ensure that all aircraft procedures, flight operating practices, standards, and records comply with the regulations of the mandatory entities;
- Obtain briefing information on the purpose of flight, weather, operation procedures, intelligence, and any special instructions. Prepare flight plans considering factors such as altitude, terrain, weather, aircraft, crew capabilities, threats, operational and training requirements, and flight procedures.
- Ensure VIP aircraft are being operated to airworthiness standards prescribed by applicable regulations, technical manuals, airworthiness directives, and good maintenance practices.
- Ensure the aircraft has a pre-flight, is properly loaded, equipped, and manned for the mission. Inspect engines, fuselage, and control surfaces for mechanical and structural soundness. Inspect and test equipment for proper operation. Ensures that weight and balance is correct, fuel supply is adequate, and equipment is properly stowed.

- Previous NVG qualification preferred;
- Must possess knowledge of ICAO regulations;
- AW139 or H145 type rating from an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) training facility or an Approved Training Organization (ATO). Other combinations of experience and education that meet these requirements may be substituted;
- No longer than 3 years since the last helicopter flight.
